Dear Acting Administrator Tavenner:

Kidney Care Partners is pleased to have the opportunity to provide the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) with comments about the Proposed Rule for Payment Policies under the Physician Fee Schedule, DME Face-to-Face Encounters, Elimination of the Requirement for Termination of Non-Random Prepayment Complex Medical Review and Other Revisions to Part B for Calendar Year (CY) 2013 (Proposed Rule). KCP is an alliance of members of the kidney care community that includes patient advocates, dialysis care professionals, providers, and manufacturers organized to advance policies that improve the quality of care for individuals with both chronic kidney disease (CKD) and irreversible kidney failure, known as End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD).¹

We support maintaining individual and group kidney disease education (KDE) program on the list of approved Medicare telehealth services. Coverage of this telehealth service furnished at an originating site, including a practitioner's office and a hospital-based renal dialysis center, ensures that all eligible beneficiaries will have access to educational and counseling services related to the care of chronic kidney disease. Individuals with kidney failure may not always have easy access to dialysis facilities or providers. KDE telehealth services provide patients with the information they need to understand their treatment options and have the tools to manage their disease. Inclusion of KDE as a covered Medicare telehealth service will ensure the continuation of high quality care.
